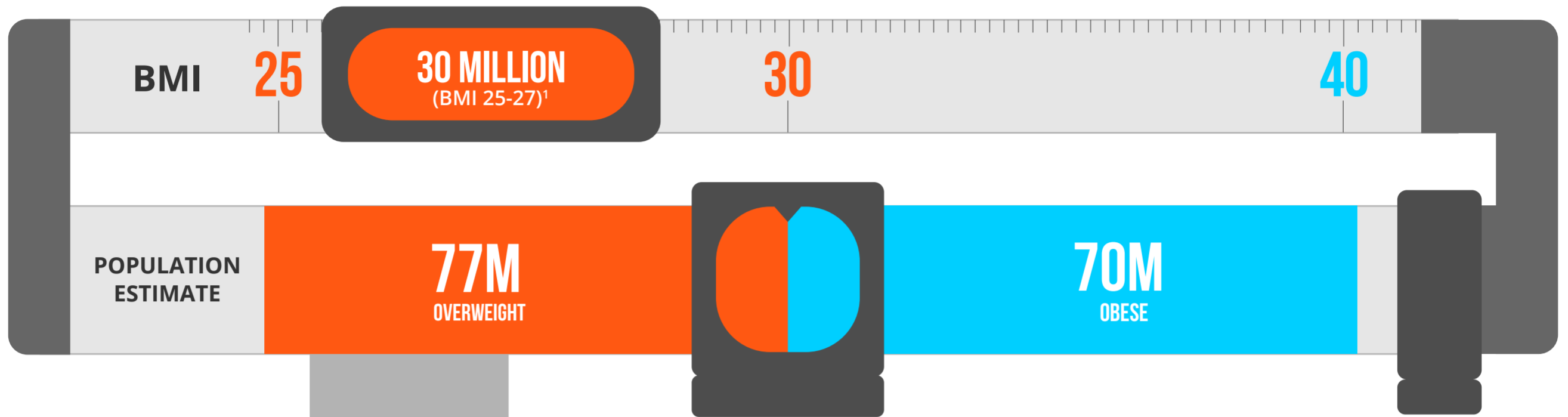


AMERICA'S WEIGHT CRISIS: TIPPING THE SCALE IN FAVOR OF EARLY ACTION

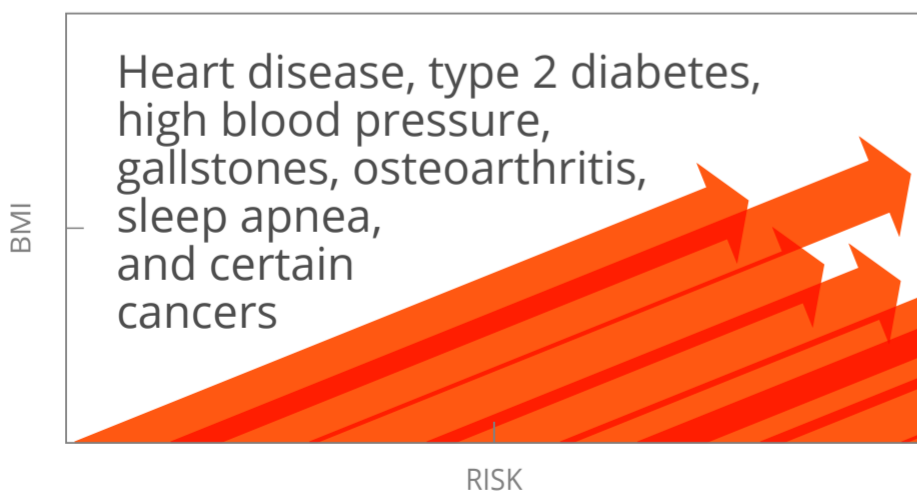


OVERWEIGHT

have overweight



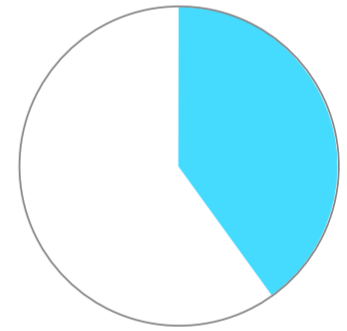
NO PRESCRIPTION THERAPIES

(BMI 25-27 kg/m²)



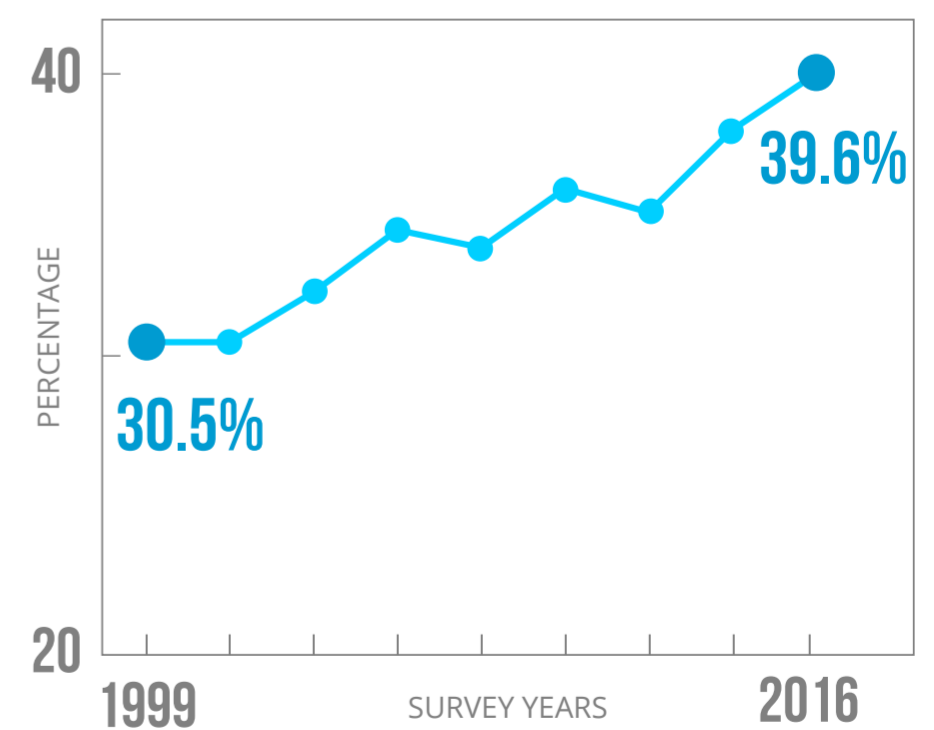
IN 2015, 40% OF
